Thanks to your volunteer hours, attendance at our events and unwavering support, CEEF is proud to share some of the highlights from this past year that we were able to accomplish together:

- Community Events: Our annual Pancake Breakfast, Book Fair and "Flavors of Cerritos" Multicultural Night not only provided vital funds but also brought our community closer together in celebration of our shared missions.
- Enhanced Learning Opportunities: We helped fund rotation programs such as Mrs. Sugino's Strive to Thrive class and Music Teacher Mrs. Lindsay's sheet music, music props and supplies, microphones and wire protectors along with Mental Health Professional Ms. Blankson's "Go Zen!" software and supplies; BrainPop online software
